MONTHLY WEATHER REVIEW - ARMIDALE NSW APRIL 2024

April 2024 was an unusually cloudy and wet month with slightly warmer than normal temperatures. Due to numerous troughs developing over northern inland New South Wales during the month there were a number of moderate daily falls of rain resulting in a total of 116.2 millimetres, 72 mm higher than the average, making it the wettest April since 1990 (167 mm). The heaviest falls occurred over the 4th and 5th totalling 62.8 mm for the two days.

Temperatures were a little higher than normal with no notable extremes.

It was a very cloudy month with only six sunny days and no frosts.

Thunderstorm activity was higher than normal for April with storms on four days.

Prevailing winds were light westerlies.

There were no noteworthy events.
