MONTHLY WEATHER REVIEW - ARMIDALE NSW MARCH 2011

March 2011 was a cloudy and warm month.

Rainfall was just below the average totaling 61.8 millimetres with the majority falling in the first week. Day temperatures were close to normal, but overnight minimums were well above normal due to numerous cloudy nights. There were no notable temperature extremes.

It was an unusually cloudy month with fine sunny weather prevailing on only 5 days.

Prevailing winds were light easterlies.

There were no noteworthy events during the month.
